

BUS FARE OPTIONS

There are 3 convenient options to pay for your transportation services.

TRANSIT PASSES are the **BEST VALUE** for passengers making 2 or more roundtrips per week, or passengers who make roundtrips with multiple stops.

Discount Tickets are a good value for the occasional rider, and Cash Fares are usually paid by the infrequent rider.

TRANSIT PASSES

30 Day Basic Pass: Monthly unlimited trips on any existing route.

DISCOUNT TICKETS

Discount tickets are available in books of 10.

CASH FARES

One Way Cash Fare - Pay as you board. Please have correct fare, as drivers cannot make change.

FARE DEFINITIONS

Transit Passes, Discount Tickets and Cash Fares are purchased based on the following groupings:

- Under 6 - FREE if accompanied by a paying adult
- Children - Ages 6-10
- Adult - Ages 11 to 59
- Senior - (over 60) or Disabled

AGENCY CONTRACTS

Discount tickets or transit passes are not available for purchase by agencies. Agencies negotiate contracts with RMTD to provide transportation to their customers. Please contact your local RMTD dispatch office for agency contract information.

What We Do...
Rides Mass Transit District is a federally funded PUBLIC transportation system. Service is available to ANYONE needing transportation. Rides provides door to door route service. The fleet consists of lift-equipped and ramped vehicles making the system fully accessible.

- How To Use RMTD...**
It's as easy as 1, 2, 3!
- 1 - Call your local county operation center.
 - 2 - State your transportation need:
A) where you need to be picked up,
B) where you need to go,
C) what time you need to be picked up,
D) if you need a return trip
 - 3 - The dispatch staff will schedule your trip for you.

Advance Reservations
Twenty four hour advance reservations are suggested, especially for rural areas where services are less frequent. A minimum of (1) one hour prior to scheduled departure is required for all services. Service is on a space available basis. If your trip is sponsored by a human service agency, their prior approval and reservation requirements would apply.

Brochures and schedules for the visually impaired are available upon request.
Service animals may accompany disabled passengers onboard.
